TASC BY-LAWS VOTE

The following proposed change to our by-laws will be voted upon at this month's general meeting. Only paid up members will be eligible to vote.

Current: **Article XI**

Office Tenure

A. No officer may be elected to serve on the Executive Board in the same capacity more than twice for a two year term but may be elected consecutively in the same position. The exception is the President and Vice President who cannot be elected consecutively in the same position.

Proposed:

Article XI

Office Tenure

A. Officers may be elected to serve on the Executive Board in the same capacity without limit in the event that there are no qualified candidates willing to serve. The exception is the President and Vice President who cannot serve more than two (2) consecutive terms but may serve in those positions again at a future time.
